Momentum Logistics has hit a major compliance milestone, with the entire fleet achieving 100% certification under the Vehicle Inspection and Certification System (VICS) in Punjab. This crucial, government-led initiative verifies that every vehicle operating for the company is fully roadworthy, directly boosting safety and sustainability.

VICS is designed to strengthen road safety and environmental protection. Through mandatory inspections, the process helps to reduce accidents caused by mechanical issues, lowers harmful emissions, and contributes to cleaner air.



VICS also supports the digitization of the transport sector by maintaining a comprehensive vehicle database, which enables better long-term oversight and planning.

Achieving full fleet certification under VICS is a clear demonstration of Momentum Logistics' commitment to meeting the highest safety and compliance standards. It confirms the dedication to operating a reliable and well-maintained fleet.

A Momentum to Empower Farmers

Historic 534 Ton Sales

IRC Dairy Products has recorded its strongest sales month in company history, selling a remarkable 534 tons in August 2025. IRC hit a new record for Whey Powder sales, which reached 120 tons. This achievement reflects the growing trust of valued customers and the collective effort of dedicated teams across production, quality, supply chain, logistics, and commercial functions.

This success is a clear indicator of IRC's continued growth trajectory and its ability to meet rising customer demand while maintaining the highest international standards of quality and service.



Powering a Sustainable Future

IRC Dairy Products has successfully installed the solar power system, marking a significant milestone in the company's journey toward sustainability, energy efficiency, and cost optimization. A capacity of 448 KW will now power various plant operations, as well as lighting and administrative buildings, reducing dependence on the national grid. This initiative is projected to generate 524,790 KWH of green energy annually, which will reduce carbon footprint by an estimated 263 tons of CO₂ emissions each year. Beyond the immediate environmental benefits, this project is expected to deliver substantial long-term cost savings and protect the company against rising energy prices.

The effort demonstrates our long-term thinking and firm commitment to sustainability.

Having established a successful partnership with Tapal Tea just one year ago, Printkraft has quickly become integral to the brand's packaging strategy.

The partnership has flourished, resulting in Printkraft successfully developing and delivering a complete range of packaging products for Tapal. Most recently, Printkraft expanded its scope into the highly competitive Green Tea category, earning the exclusive privilege of being the only producer for all of Tapal Green Tea's boxes.

Lotte Kolson's Packaging

Printkraft successfully resolved a major challenge and enabled Lotte Kolson to export its Choco Pie from Pakistan to markets like Korea and China. The difficulty stemmed from developing the packaging on a specific requirement of high-grammage 450gsm Duplex board. Which was unavailable locally and was causing machinery run-ability issues.

Following a dedicated year of internal R&D and international trials, Printkraft engineered the solution, leading to the product's successful launch. This achievement now allows Lotte Kolson to explore additional export territories.



Global Food Safety Excellence

Printkraft has successfully completed the surveillance audit against the rigorous FSSC 22000 Version 6.0 standard. This successful audit means the company sustains its globally recognized Food Safety Management System.

The FSSC 22000 V6.0 standard is critical for ensuring the safety and quality of food products. Its primary purpose is to specify requirements for:

- *Preventing food contamination and ensuring product integrity.*
- *Reducing the risk of foodborne illnesses throughout the production process.*
- *Meeting stringent customer and regulatory requirements across the food industry.*

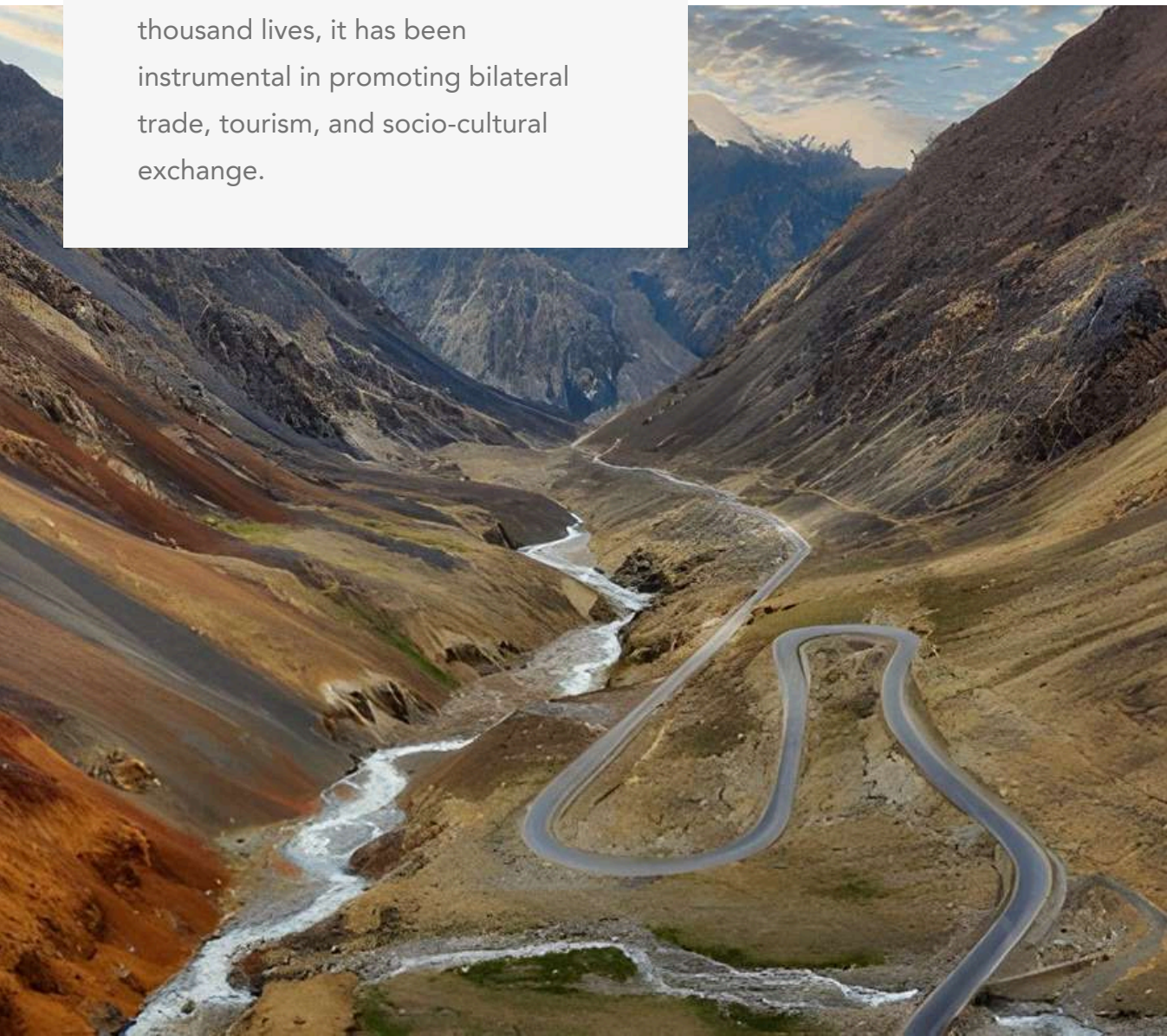

The Karakoram Highway

The Karakoram Highway (KKH), also known as the National Highway 35 (N-35), extending 1300 km from Hasan Abdal (Pakistan) to Kashgar (China) is a globally recognized engineering marvel.

The KKH traverses through the confluence of the Himalayas, Karakoram, and Hindu Kush mountain ranges. Built over 20 years (1959-1979) at the cost of over a thousand lives, it has been instrumental in promoting bilateral trade, tourism, and socio-cultural exchange.

The KKH forms the foundational artery for the infrastructure component of the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC), making it a pivotal geopolitical asset that unlocks access to Gwadar Port and serves as the primary route for future regional economic growth and connectivity with Central Asia.
