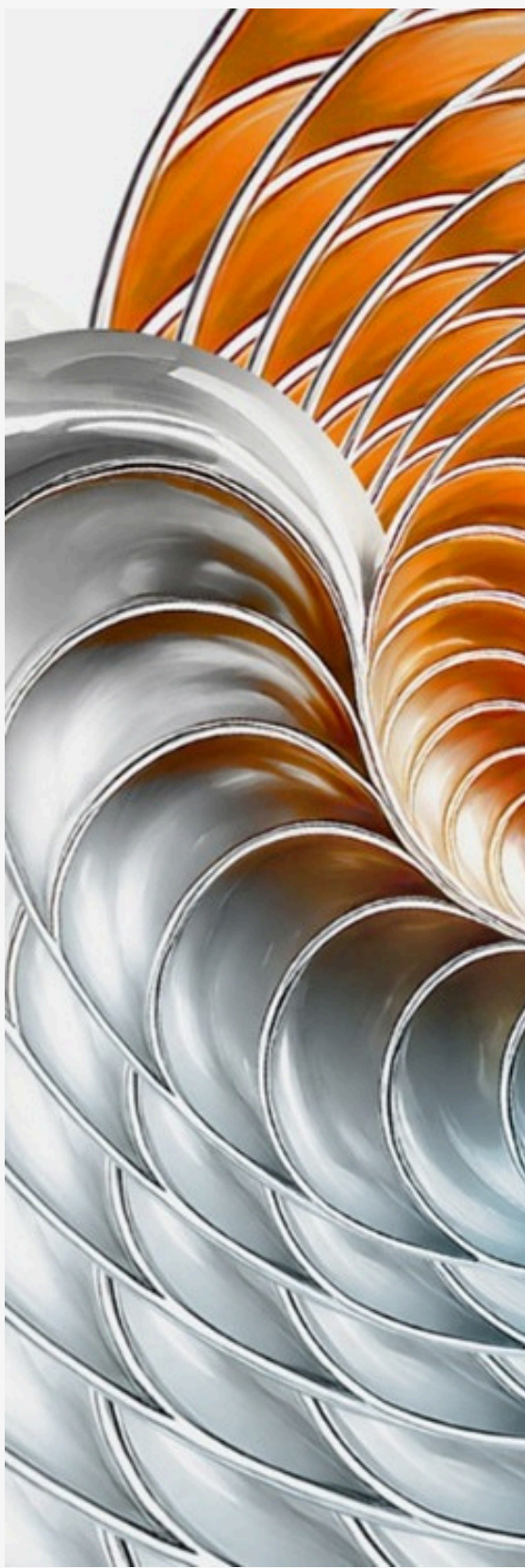
This journey reminded me that growth takes patience and commitment. I move forward with gratitude - for the learning, the trust, and a workplace that truly invests in its people.

Pakistan's Highest Cold Desert Katpana

The Katpana Desert, located near Skardu in Gilgit-Baltistan at an elevation of approximately 2,200 meters, is recognized as one of the highest cold deserts in the world. Unlike conventional deserts, Katpana experiences extreme winters, with temperatures often falling below -15°C , making it a rare geographical phenomenon.

During winter months, the desert's sand dunes are frequently blanketed by snow, creating a unique landscape where arid terrain and sub-zero alpine climate coexist.

This rare combination places Katpana among a small number of cold deserts globally and makes it significant for climate studies, high-altitude ecology, and environmental research.

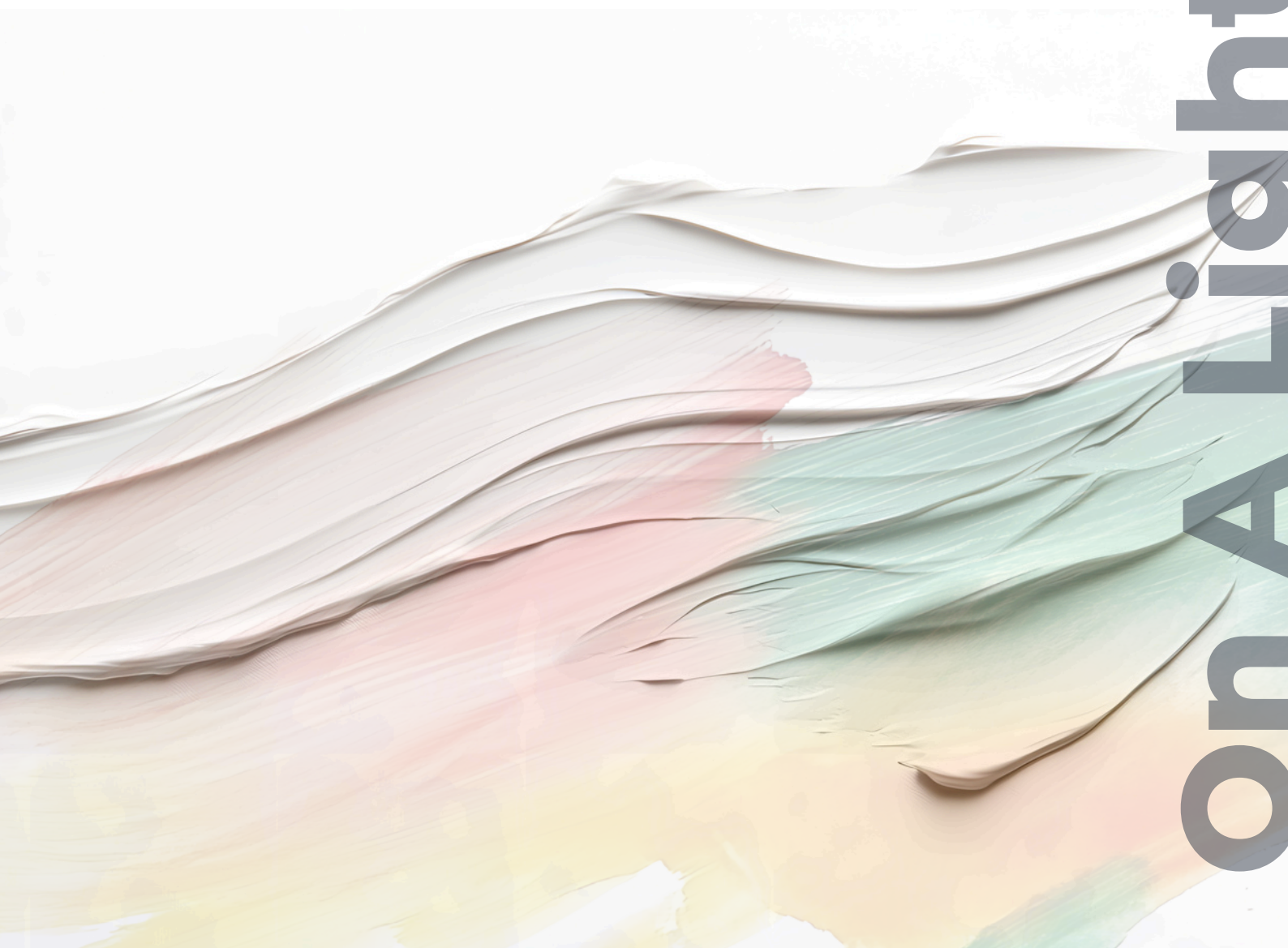
The desert forms part of the broader Upper Indus Basin ecosystem, highlighting Pakistan's exceptional climatic diversity and reinforcing the region's importance in understanding climate variability across high-mountain environments.
