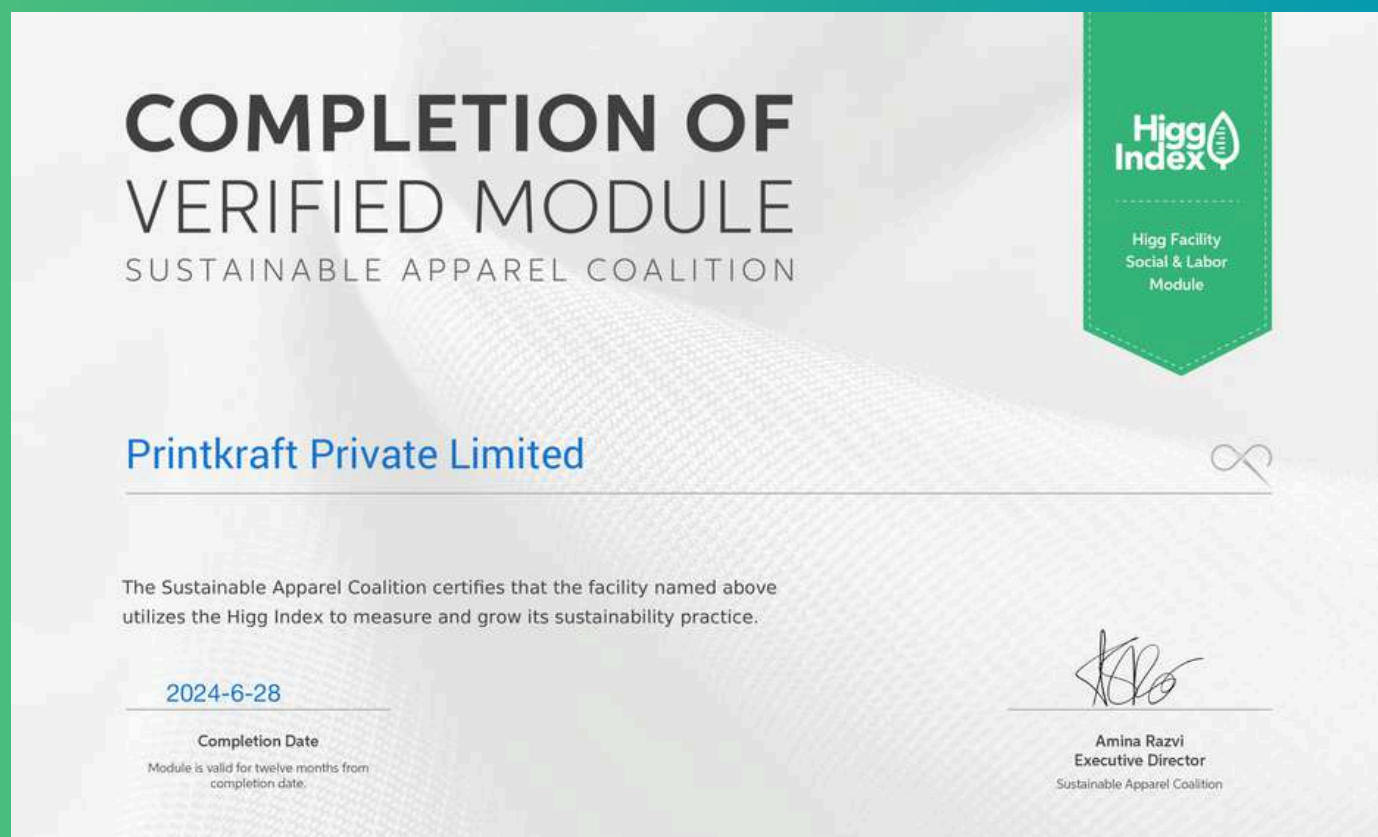
Printkraft's SLCP Certification, Advancing Social and Labor Standards
